Learning begins August 30th 2021-22 COVID-19 Preventative Measures

The following measures will be in place for the 2021-22 school year. *These guidelines are subject to change based on public health conditions and requirements from the DHD #10.*



Grades K-12: **masks are optional inside schools but are strongly recommended.** However, all bus riders are **required to wear masks on buses** according to the federal mandate.



Hand washing/Sanitizing regular hygiene and hand sanitizing will be encouraged.



Cleaning and Disinfecting all surfaces will be disinfected every evening.



Improved ventilation all classrooms have air filtration systems.

Additional COVID Measures

COVID testing is **NOT** required but available at the Wexford Adolescent Wellness Center.

Vaccinations are **NOT** required but recommended and available at the Wexford Adolescent Wellness Center for staff and students at no cost.

K-5 students will cohort with their grade-level peers.

We will maximize space in the classrooms to allow for distancing.

Parent Notifications Parents will be notified if their child was in close contact with a positive COVID case. COVID positive students and staff cannot return to school until the conditions for re-entry have been met.
