Dear CAPS Families,

The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services ordered new COVID restrictions that impact Cadillac High School and Cadillac Innovation High School. Currently, our CHS students are learning remotely. Beginning Wednesday both CHS and CIHS students will be learning remotely returning to face-to-face instruction on December 9th. All athletics and co-curricular activities are suspended until December 8th. Food will be distributed to all 9-12th grade students on Thursdays from 3:00-4:00 PM at the Jr/Sr High School bus loop. We will continue to work with our local health department to evaluate COVID numbers in each building and to notify our parents when staff or students have tested positive.

Based on the guidance of our Health Department and lack of COVID exposure or spread at the lower levels, we will continue to welcome our PreK-8th grade students to the building to learn face to face. All CAPS students will continue to wear masks and all safety protocols continue to be in place. We ask that you respectfully continue partnering with us in finding the balance in providing a safe learning environment and educating all of our students during this health crisis.
